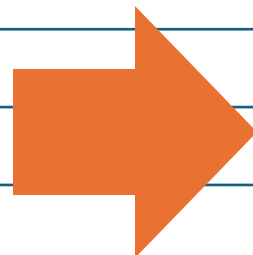
- **Name:** European Library Associations' Network

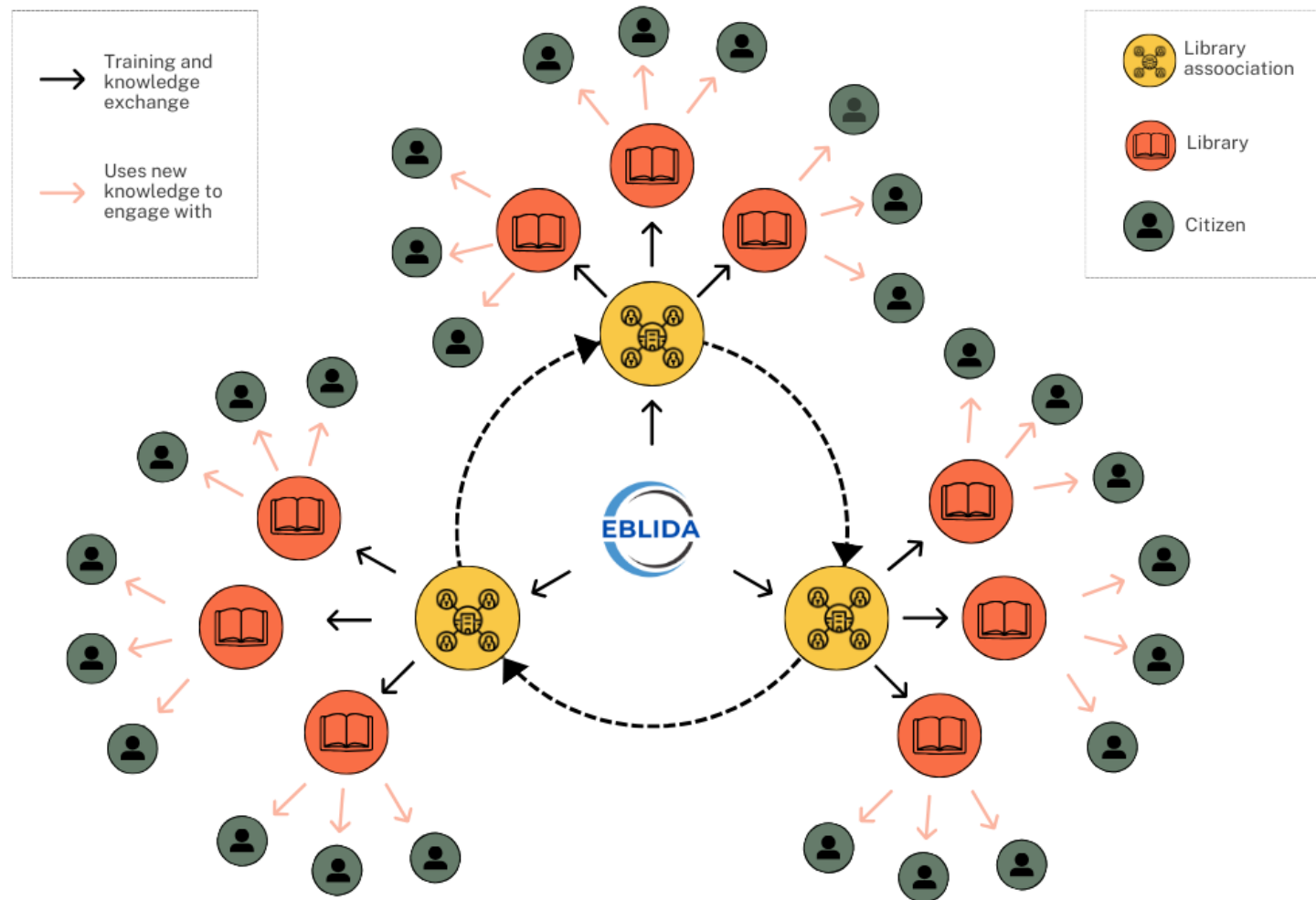

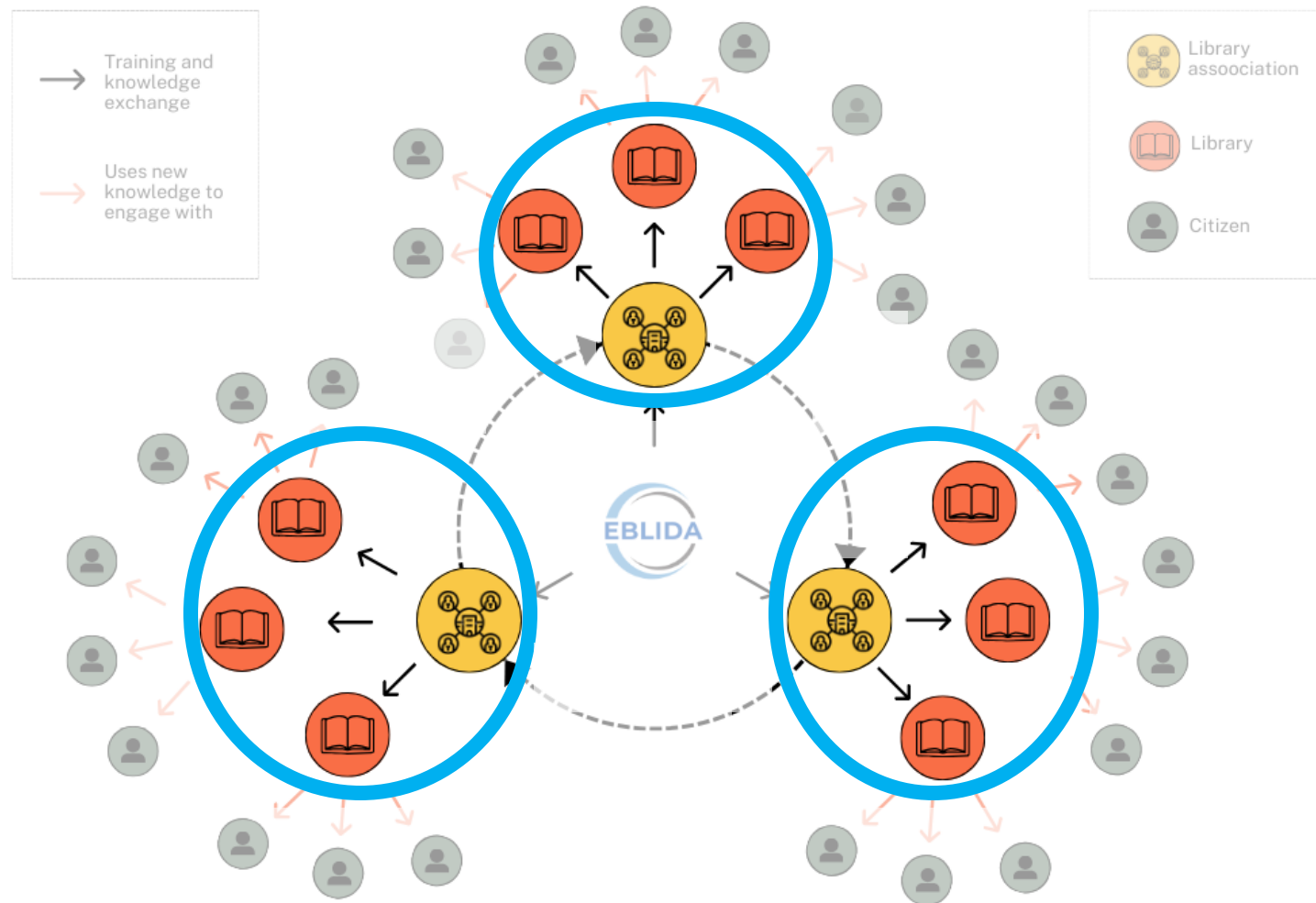
