Cataloguing service for all 300+ public libraries in Flanders (BE)

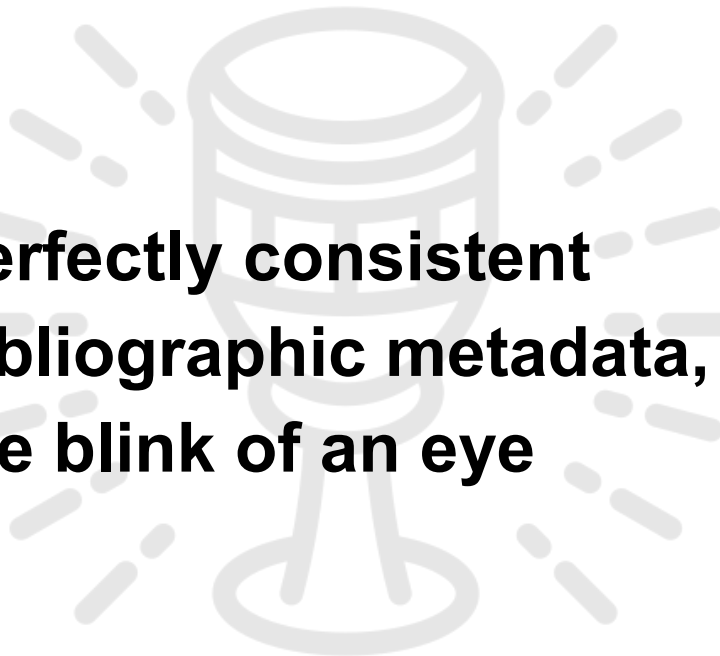
25.000 new descriptions/year + enhancing and correcting existing records: labour-intensive, often repetitive

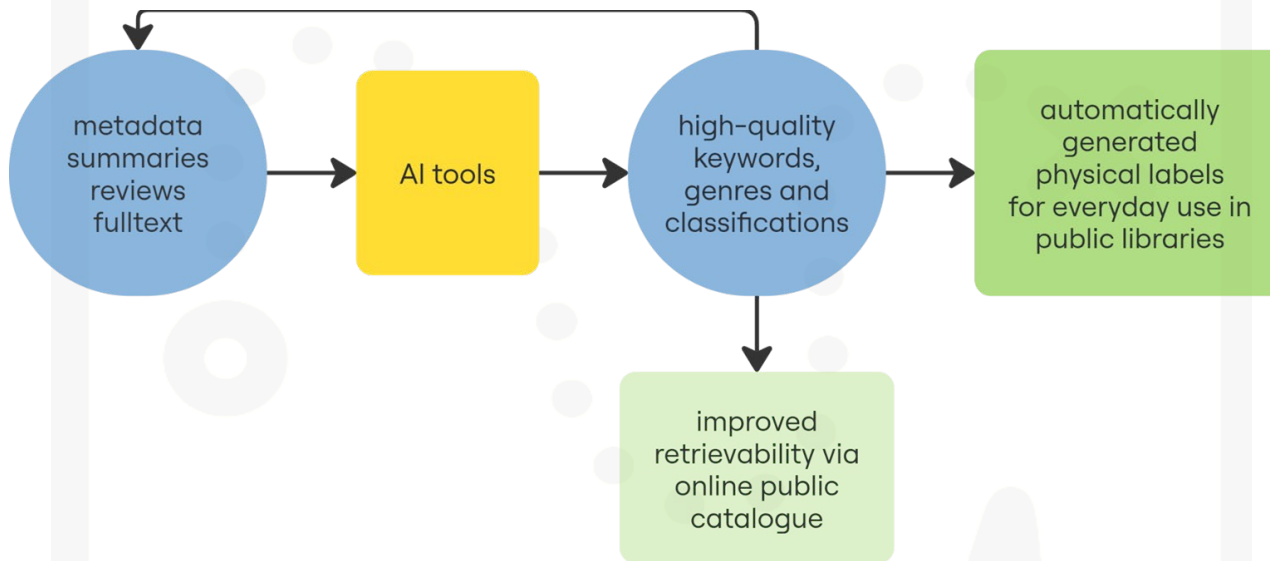
