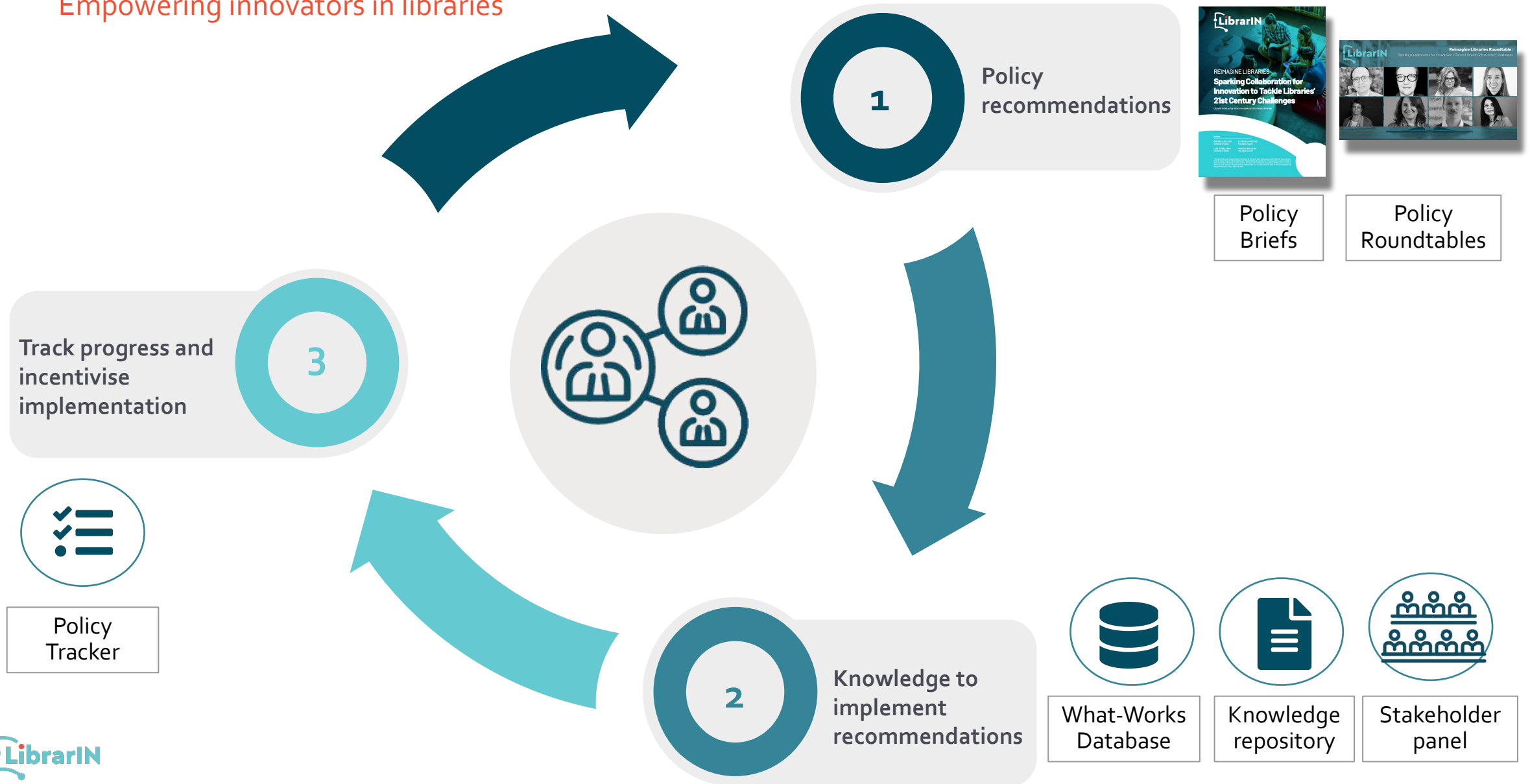

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Introduction

The LibrarIN project has developed a comprehensive toolkit designed to support library staff and policymakers in advancing social innovation within European libraries. It achieves this by offering resources at the policy, library, and academic levels. Drawing on data, good practices, and research insights from across Europe, the toolkit serves as a valuable resource for policymaking, political advocacy, and academic discourse. It provides inspiration for localised innovation and collaboration, while also offering opportunities for (self-)assessment of library services and strategies. The toolkit consists of the following three tools:



Library policy tracker

Policy Level

Measures the extent to which national policies align with EU-level recommendations regarding LibrarIN research areas.

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What-works database

Library Level

Collects experiences, case studies, and good practices that promote value co-creation and social innovation in libraries.

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Research knowledge base

Academic Level

A repository of papers, studies, and reports on value co-creation and social innovation in the library sector.

Benchmark and monitor how EU recommendations are applied across Europe
